Introduction



Kepler requires a computer with a CD rom drive, Windows 95/98/ME/2000, 32 MB RAM memory, and about 450 MB disk space. Kepler also includes an additional 450 megabytes of graphics and sound files which can be left on the CD, or optionally may be installed on the hard drive. Speakers are not required but are recommended. Kepler also runs on PowerMac computers with Virtual PC software installed.

Kepler is a revolutionary product unlike anything else: so complete and easy to use that a complete novice can use it to obtain useful information, but so sophisticated that it uses cutting edge astrological theory (harmonics and cosmobiology, for example), to produce some of the interpretive reports - don't worry, you don't need to understand what these are to use Kepler! Kepler is a complete astrological software system that provides a huge number of technical calculations, interpretations, astrological education, a Multimedia presentation, graphics, etc.

Accuracy and Time Range of Calculations: Planets can be calculated from the years 999 BC to 2300 AD, except the asteroids and 8 transneptunian planets which in some cases cannot be calculated before 1000 AD. Accuracy of all planets is less than 1 second of arc, and the accuracy for the asteroids, transneptunian planets, and Chiron is 1 minute of arc. Kepler uses the Swiss Ephemeris planetary routines, which are the most accurate planetary routines available for personal computers.

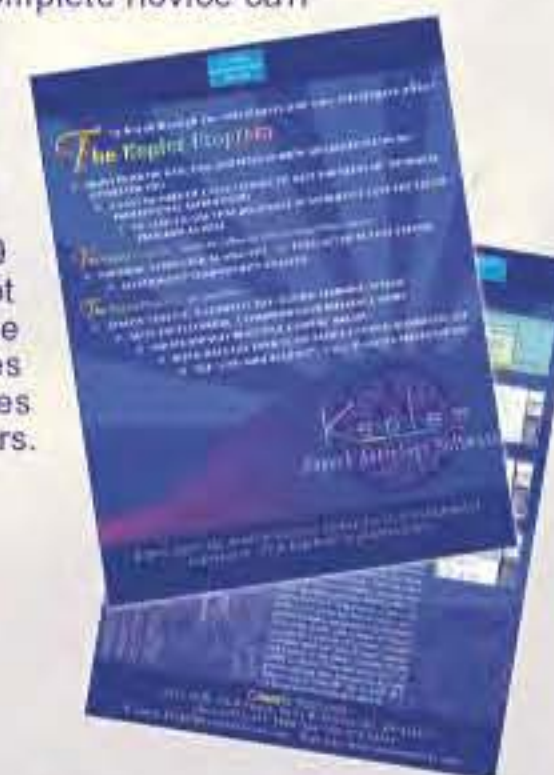

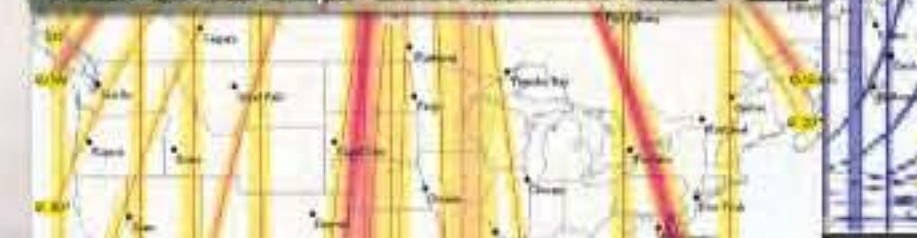

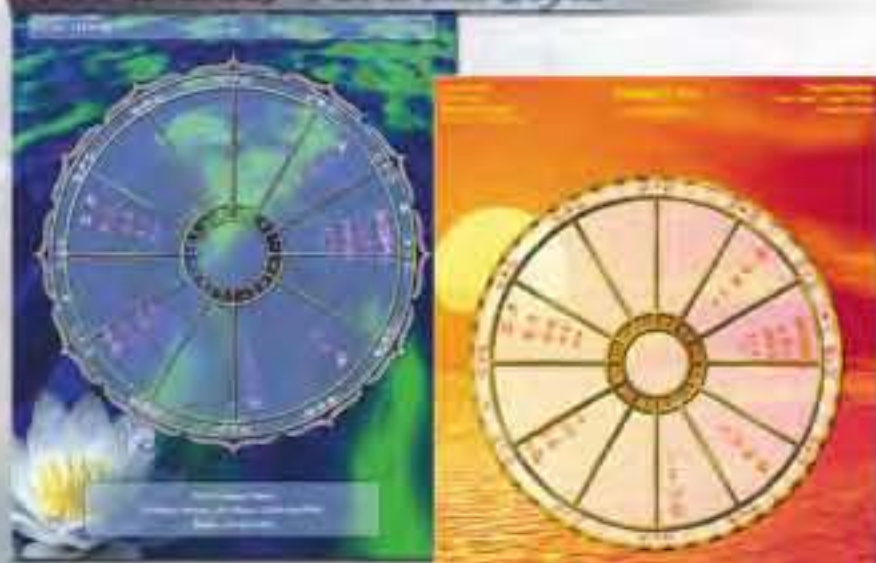
Art Wheels: Art wheels are beautiful chart wheels. Our art wheels were designed by graphic artist Paul Guess.

Kepler comes with a complete atlas of the world with over 260,000 cities. Easy-to-use: Type in upper or lower case, see cities as you type, and narrow the search to a specific country or state if desired. The time zone and daylight savings time information is complete and up-to-date; every year some countries change laws regarding daylight savings time, and these changes are entered into our tables. This is absolutely necessary in order to calculate a chart accurately!!!

Flexibility:

Customize aspects and orbs, and have up to 3 pre-defined aspect sets. Edit any feature of an interpretive report, translate reports to a different language, or even create your own interpretive reports from scratch! You can customize regular wheels, BiWheel, TriWheel, QuadWheels, transit-to-natal aspects, progressed-to-natal aspects, Profile Category Scores and Time Line details. Select any TrueType font for use in interpretations. The above list is a sample of some of the features that can be customized, and is not a complete list. Easy to change the orb of aspects in natal and compatibility interpretation by selecting a report from a listing then edit it on the screen.

It is also easy to "touch up" a wheel; while selecting a wheel style, there is a "Touch Up" button that can be selected to access features that are most commonly desired. The "Color Scheme" option, for example, when selecting a chart wheel, allows you to quickly and easily change the entire range of colors used in a chart wheel to produce exciting effects with little effort.

You can print chart wheels in heliocentric, altitude-azimuth, horizon, and even right ascension coordinates.

Planet Position in the wheel can either be in the traditional zodiac style or in 0-360 degree format which some astrologers prefer for horizon, heliocentric, and right ascension charts.

You can also print midpoint trees and most other printouts using these coordinates systems.

Easy to make a new chart wheel style the default. You can set a default Regular, BiWheel, TriWheel, and QuadWheel style. **Use either Pluto glyph: _ or :**

The **Vertex, Equatorial Ascendant, and 8 transneptunian planets** can be put in the chart wheel.

The **Part of Fortune** can be calculated using the ancient formula (Asc+Sun-Moon for night charts).

It is possible to have arrows on angular cusps, different ways of placing planet positions in the chart wheels, and dozens of other ways that wheels and other printouts can be customized to suit your taste.

Combine different transit calculations: Kepler provides many formats for viewing transit and progressed listings, and the most popular one is time line format. You can quickly select different kinds of forecast methods (for example, transit-to-natal, progressed-to-natal, tertiary progressed-to-progressed, etc.) with different selections of planets and aspects for each one and see all of this information beautifully and clearly presented on your screen or printed out.

E-mail the chart wheels interpretive reports, directly from Kepler:

Enter the e-mail address of the person you want to e-mail the report to, and it will be e-mailed. Note that you must have an Internet Service Provider (ISP) for this function to work. Most of the free services and even a few that are not free (most notably AOL) will not work. Only services that provide your own outgoing mail server name and user ID will work with Kepler's e-mail feature.

Your Choice of Birth Data Files:

Read chart data from WinStar, Solar Fire, and AstroDatabank directly in Kepler's Data Entry screen! There is no need to go through the tedious process of exporting and importing; the birth chart data in these programs can be read directly by Kepler. If you are a user of one of these astrology programs, you can now easily expand your horizons with Kepler's awesome features without re-entering any of your data.

Live Mini Reading



Batch Mode & Interactive Mode:

Kepler works beautifully in both "batch" mode and "interactive" mode. You may not be familiar with the terms "batch mode" and "interactive mode" but both modes are important to make an astrology program easy and fun. You can easily check the printouts you want and send them to the printer (batch mode), or you can view printouts on the screen, select any printout desired and immediately see it and then click on the Print button to print it if you like (Interactive mode). Batch mode is great when you need a lot of printouts, and interactive mode is great when you want to "play" with the program, poking around and exploring different ideas. Kepler provides both in a very easy-to-use way.

Ease of Use:

* While you enter the person's name (or place of birth), a list of names (or places) to select from automatically appears - no hunting around or pressing keys to tell Kepler to look up the data.

* Handy features like the ability to remove the listing of famous charts so you can see only your own with 2 mouse clicks make using the program fun and easy.

* Just do what you need to do: for example suppose you need to change the spelling of a person's name that has been saved on disk; all you do is change the spelling and the database is updated for you. Removing data is just as easy.

* When entering the place of birth, you can simply begin entering the place, and then you also have the option to narrow the listing of cities to one country or state, a useful feature when you are unsure of the correct spelling.

Entering the person's name:

You can see at the top of the screen whether you are reading All Data, Your Data, Famous, and Third party. Two mouse clicks and you have changed which data you are accessing, and there is no slowing down of the speed at which names are read from disk.

Entering the place of birth: It is always easy to read in the place of birth: just start typing and the cities appear. But what if you are having difficulty finding the place?

Select the state or country first if you like. For example, if someone is born in Cincinnati, Ohio, you might not be able to remember the correct spelling: is it "Cincinnati" (correct) or "Cinnincinati" (incorrect), etc. By selecting "Ohio" first it reduces the number of cities to select from thereby making it much easier to find the town you are looking for.

Entering the name and place of birth is not case sensitive: In other words, if the person's name is "Smith,Bill", you no longer need to enter "Smi"; you can now enter "smi" or "SMI", for example, and the name will still be found. Entering a place is also not case sensitive.

Printing to file is easy: You can select a default directory for reports to be printed to, and you have the option to save files in Rich Text Format. Files saved in Rich Text Format can be read into a word processing program and retain most formatting characteristics.

Any printout being viewed on the screen can be printed by simply clicking the "Print This Screen" button, or e-mailed by clicking the E-mail This Screen button.

If you are pre-selecting printouts ("batch mode") and need to un-select a printout, just un-check the box.

Seemingly complex requests like a BiWheel with Jack's natal chart in the center and Jill's progressed chart on the outside is very easy to do.

Visual previews that show you the AstroMap, wheel style or wheel feature that you are selecting make it easy to get exactly the printout desired before you view or print it.

Customize a wheel while you select it, and also make these selections the new default if you like.

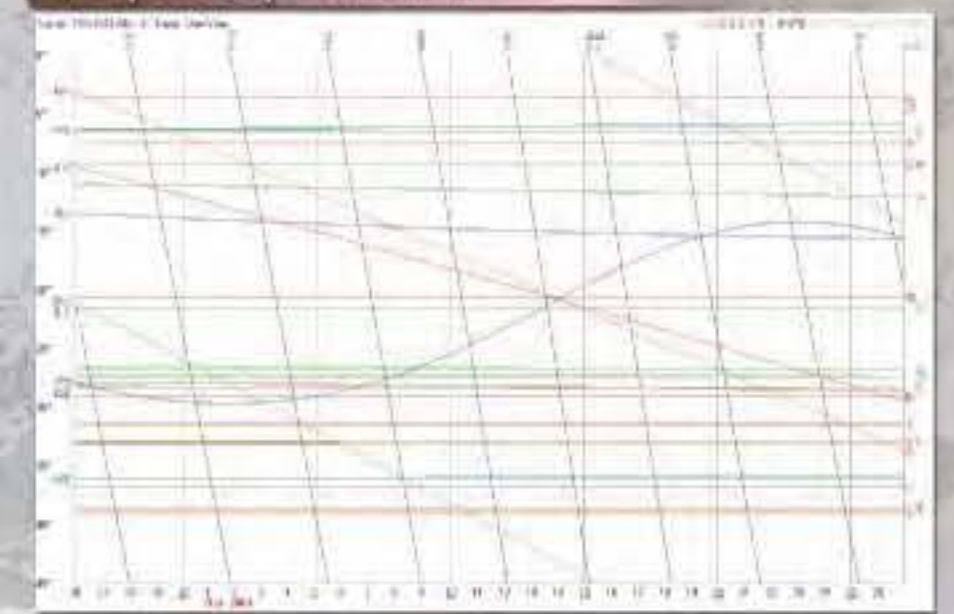

Over the years we have refined the program with attention to little details like those mentioned above to make Kepler fun to use. The above list is a sample of some of the features that make Kepler easy to use, and is not a complete list.

Research Capabilities:

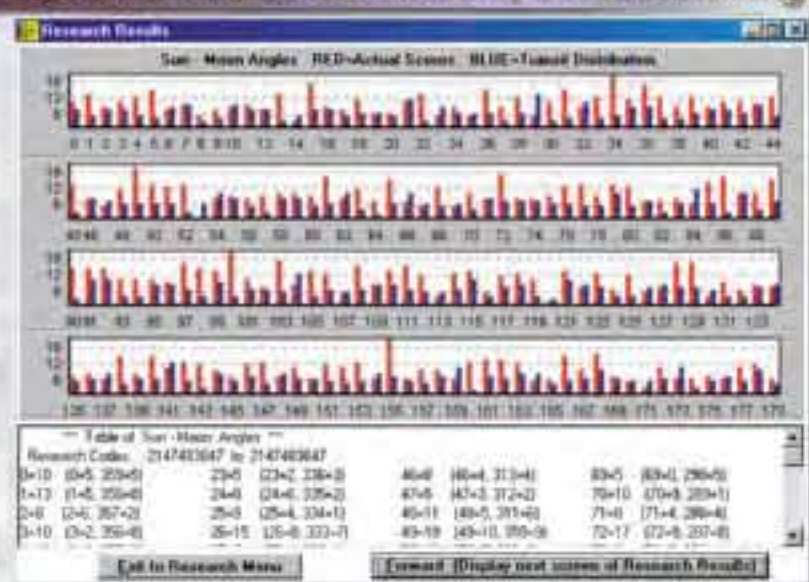
For the research-oriented astrologer there is research capability. You can find out which charts have a particular aspect or planet in a sign or house. For example, you can find out which charts have Sun trine Jupiter. You can also select a specific range of research codes to study particular groups of people, such as just athletes, or just basketball players, or just musicians, or just singers, or just jazz singers.

Kepler has highly sophisticated research capabilities. In addition to basic research capabilities, Kepler can analyze all angles between all planets and print a sorted list of which angles occur most often. This is "assumptionless" research and it can reveal startling new information. This kind of research is designed for serious researchers who are willing to take days or weeks to analyze and think about the research results. If you are a serious researcher, this is a tool that is likely to open new doors for you!

The next step in the research process is even more exciting. Suppose that you decide from the research results that the group of people you are studying is more likely to have Sun conjunct, square, or opposition Saturn, Moon in Capricorn, or also Moon, Mercury, and Venus in hard aspect to Saturn. You also conclude that the Sun square Saturn aspect is most important, Sun opposition Saturn is next most important, etc.

You can create an "astrological signature" with the exact weights that you want for each astrological factor that is part of the astrological signature. Your astrological profile can be as complex as you like, and you can even have factors such as: "if Sun is in Capricorn and Moon is in Capricorn, give 10 points, but if only the Sun in Capricorn give 5 points, and if only the Moon is in Capricorn, give 3 points". Developing these complex rules for your astrological signature is not trivial; this is a tool for the serious researcher. These are tools that enable one to validate astrology and are for the serious-minded researcher.

Research Result: Table of Sun-Moon Angles



Kepler includes 4 hypothetical astrological signatures that were developed with this research capability: alcoholism, image consultant (a profession), football quarterback, and baseball pitcher. If additional research confirms these astrological signatures, then these hypotheses become theories

that if repeatedly duplicated become the beginnings of a science of astrology. When researching Aspects, Midpoints, or Harmonics you can compare the frequency that occurs in the chart being studied to the frequency that occurs during any time period.

If this level of serious research is not your cup of tea, that's OK. Kepler provides a vast amount of information for various kinds and levels of interests. You can enjoy the results of the research in any case by running the hypothetical astrological signatures on people you know to see what scores they get.

Vedic Calculations Heliocentric and Altitude-Azimuth Charts

The ayanamsha, which is the difference between the tropical and sidereal zodiacs, can be easily selected from a menu. You can also enter a custom value.

Vedic calculations: Dasas and Bhuktis, Shad Bala, Nakshatras, Vargas, and Gochara. You can also produce the Vedic square chart wheel styles (both North Indian, South Indian style, and Western Style). You may also print the wheel in western style (circle).

Kepler provides you with all of the fundamental features of Vedic astrology. You can print the nakshatra of your Moon, with a short interpretation of its meaning, and a listing of the planetary periods (dasas and subdasas throughout the lifetime of the person).

Heliocentric and Altitude-Azimuth Charts: You can print chart wheels, and also other printouts like midpoint structures and harmonic chart listings in heliocentric or altitude-azimuth coordinates.

Two different variations of altitude-azimuth positions are provided, and you can also produce printouts with right ascension positions. Heliocentric chart wheels, and heliocentric transits and progressions can be produced.

Vedic Chart and Vargas: Vedic astrology differs from western astrology in many ways. There are 2 styles of Vedic chart wheels, the North Indian and South Indian style, and both of these styles are different from the traditional western style round wheel. Planetary strengths are calculated using complex formulae, and there are 16 "divisional charts" or "vargas" that are used. The planets Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto are not included. All of these basics of Vedic astrology are included in Kepler.

Store Birth Data on disk and have notes with each person

Store Birth Data on disk and have notes with each person: Kepler stores data on disk that can be easily looked up later, or to research the data. You can have notes (up to 360 characters) with each person's birth data. The notes section is helpful if you need to record a special note about this person, and it is also used to give some information about the famous people and businesses that are included with the Kepler program.

Astro Clock:

You can view the current positions of the planets in real time with Kepler's AstroClock feature. You can select the place so that it calculates an AstroClock wherever you are.

Kepler Worktop:

Within the Kepler program is a software module that we call Kepler Workshhop.

Kepler Workshop can produce the following printouts: the Graphic Ephemeris, Text Ephemeris, Eclipse Maps, and the following Vedic calculations: Charts and Vargas, Gochara, and Dasas and Bhuktis

Graphic Ephemeris: A popular feature used in the cosmobiology school of astrology, but very powerful and fascinating for all astrologers. You can combine transits, progressions, and directions in one graphic ephemeris. The color coding helps distinguish the various planets. A 45 degree, 22 degree, 30 degree, and other ephemerides can be viewed. You can also view a graphic ephemeris of declinations or latitudes of the planets. You can include the 4 major asteroids, Chiron, and transneptunian planets if you wish.

Text Ephemeris: This is handy not only for planetary positions, but you can also view an ephemeris for any of 1,000 asteroids. If you own the optional 22,000 asteroids option, you can view an ephemeris of any of these as well.

Eclipse Maps: View the path of the solar eclipse for any solar eclipse between the years 2900 B.C. and 2900 A.D.

Vedic Wheels and Shad Bala (planetary strengths): Both North Indian and South Indian style wheels, as well as the western bhava wheel, can be selected. A detailed breakdown of planetary strength calculations is available if you wish to see this detailed analysis.

Dasas and Bhuktis: You may include antarardasas if you wish to have a detailed list of planetary periods. Interpretations of dasas and bhuktis (but not antarardasas) can also be produced!

Gochara: In Vedic astrology a set of rules is used to determine the influence of transiting planets on the natal charts is used, which is known as Gochara. The gochara system is presented in an easy-to-read graphic format.

If you own Kepler Ver 4.7 or Kepler 5 and at least one of the optional interpretive reports, then Cosmic Patterns will create for you, free of charge, a web site with your own astrology chart service. Your customers receive the report displayed on their screen, and an e-mail message thanking the customer for the order and providing a link for them to see their report for up to 3 days after purchase. This entire service is provided for you and maintained for you by Cosmic Patterns; you need to do nothing but advertise your service; we take care of the rest for you!

you this information even 10 years ago, but now it is much faster to obtain and easier to read. In Kepler Ver 5.0, you no longer have to individually select these printouts. A screen is displayed that allows you to check which forecasts you want, and you can save this set of selections as a default for the future. The forecasts are displayed in time line format. The simple text listing format is still available, but only the time line format is available in this more elegant method of selecting forecasts.

We also made improvements to the time line format: now the calendar date is printed periodically so that while scrolling through the printout, you can see what the dates are without needing to scroll up and down repeatedly.

Also, the date when the aspect is exact now appears in the time line printout. Because the date was not given, some Kepler users continued to use text listings, but now this limitation has been removed.

The time line format is quickly becoming the preferred method of most Kepler users, and with these new features will undoubtedly continue to become more popular. The time line format has the advantages of allowing you to quickly and easily see what astrological influences are occurring, when they occur, and how strong they are at any time.

After making your selections, you can scroll through the list of transits and progressions without needing to jump between printouts.

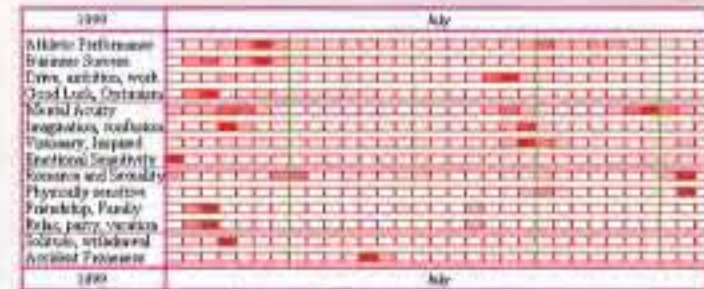


Print transit-to-natal, transit-to-transit, progressed-to-natal, and progressed-to-progressed listings in "Time Line Format".

You can select from 1 to 12 months (unlike the "old" format of simply listing aspects, you are limited to a maximum of a 12-month period to view at a time).

The Time Line Format allows you to glance down the screen (or page, if you have printed it) to see exactly what aspects are in effect and how strong they are. You can, of course, include planet-to-midpoint, or midpoint-to-planet, or minor aspects, and you can choose which planets you want to include in the printout. Parallels of declination can also be included.

Suppose that you are an astrologer and you would like for your clients the following information for the coming year: outer planet transits to the natal chart, secondary progressed to natal, secondary progressed to progressed, and solar arc to natal aspects. Kepler has been able to provide



On the left is a "Time Line Profile" printout shows you when you are most accident prone, etc.

The Time Line Profile is calculated based on what aspects are in effect at a given time, how close to exact the aspect is, and what weighting is given to each aspect. You can, for example, assign 10 points to transiting Mars square Uranus, and 8 points to transiting Sun square Mars. You can change the weights that we have assigned to the aspects and midpoint structures for each category. You can also produce Time Line Profiles with, or without, midpoints.

Eclipse Information and Declination



In the section of the transit-to-natal listing above you see "(SE)" displayed after one of the transiting Sun aspects. "(SE)" indicates a solar eclipse. You have the option of detecting that a solar eclipse or lunar eclipse is making an aspect to a natal planet. Kepler denotes this by printing "(SE)" (solar eclipse) or "(LE)" next to the transiting Sun to natal planet aspect. You can also detect not only eclipses but all new moons and full moons as well. These are designated by "(NM)" (new moon) and "(FM)" (full moon). Kepler can also detect transiting and progressed declinations. In the printout above, the 8th aspect listed is transiting Sun parallel natal Uranus.

Fixed Stars: Kepler can produce a list of conjunctions to fixed stars. Typically, an astrologer would select conjunctions of planets to 361 named fixed stars with an orb of 1 degree. For something very different, you can select conjunctions within a 10' orb of planets to over 8,000 fixed stars and fixed points! You can also select conjunctions that are conjunctions in longitude and latitude (near occultations).

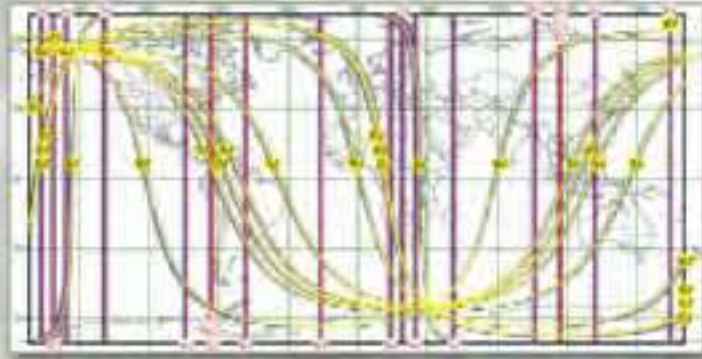

AstroMaps for the 21st Century

AstroMaps are wonderful. You can see lines going through a map that show where a particular planetary planet influence is very strong for you. However, until now it has not been possible to see exactly how far the influence extends away from the line, so you cannot determine exactly what areas are affected by the lines.

Now the Kepler program allows you to print AstroMaps with a blue-shaded area surrounding the aspect line so you can see what area the influence extends to. You can change the orb, if desired, as well. These new AstroMaps with blue-shaded orbs make all other AstroMaps obsolete.

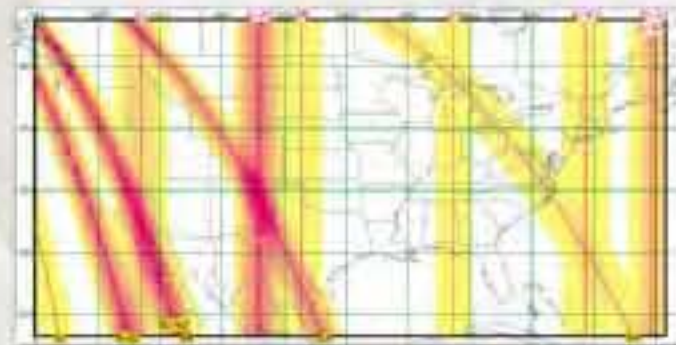


relocated Ascendant if you like. Many of our customers have found that including midpoints in their AstroMaps improves their accuracy. Treasure Maps include relevant midpoints and minor aspects, which you will find are not so minor in their influence. Vedic astrologers have used noviles for centuries, and they are powerful in AstroMaps as well. You can also change which aspects are included in an AstroMap or Treasure Map and the orbs used.

Map Guides: You can print a listing of what the lines in an AstroMap mean. You can give this to your customers (and study it yourself as well, of course) to learn what all those lines and colored areas on your map mean.

Technical Features of AstroMaps:

There are 2 ways that astrologers calculate AstroMaps: in longitude and in mundo. A discussion of these technicalities would be quite lengthy, so we won't get into it now, but suffice it to say that astrologers typically make calculations in longitude; that is how birth charts and the vast majority of astrological analyses are done. However, some astrologers prefer to calculate AstroMaps using in mundo positions. In Kepler you can easily select either in mundo or longitude positions for traditional AstroMaps.



For AstroMaps with blue-shaded orbs and Treasure Maps you must use longitude, but for traditional AstroMaps which have only lines, you can select longitude or in mundo calculations.

By the way, an AstroMap with in mundo aspects is very interesting; the planetary aspect lines criss-cross each other in the map rather than being mostly parallel.

Treasure Maps:

You can now print an AstroMap that focuses on certain areas of life. There are 5 Treasure Maps that you can print: Love and Romance, Vocation and Career, Friendship and Family, Imagination and Inspiration, and Excitement and Instability.

The Love and Romance Treasure Map, for example, shows areas of the world where love and romance are more likely to be drawn to you. The most powerful areas are shaded in red, and less powerful areas are shaded in yellow. Treasure Maps allow you to provide the information that you really want to know about.

The Treasure Map, like the Profile Time Line discussed above, is calculated based on the strength that you give each aspect, and also the orb of the aspect in that location. For example, you can give 10 points to Venus conjunct the relocated Ascendant, and 8 points to Venus sextile the

MERLIN: This interpretation of the birth chart is written by Gina Ronco and Agnes Nightingale. The interpretations are clearly written, with sensitivity, and are free of astrological jargon. The Merlin Report uses a sophisticated technique that leads the reader from one idea to the next so that the report is not as "choppy" and does not contain as many contradictions as most other computer-generated astrological interpretations. LIFE PATH: The Life Path Report offers a unique blending of the psychological, spiritual, and material plane potentials found in each individual horoscope. This report gives all planet in sign, planet in house and major aspects interpretations. North node interpretations by sign and house position, retrograde planets and elemental emphasis make this a well rounded report. Included is a special section devoted to house rulerships which add yet another level of understanding to the overall picture. About 10-13 pages in length. Currently available in English only.

COSMO NATAL: This report is included in the Kepler program. It is a very short natal report that interprets the planets in zodiac signs and in aspect to each other. The planets in houses are NOT interpreted. COSMO COMPATIBILITY: Only about 5-8 pages long, this report compares the Sun signs and Moon signs, and interprets major aspects between the 2 charts that involve an inner planet. Although short, this report focuses on some of the major issues in a relationship, and is the same high quality text that is in the complete Compatibility Report. The Cosmo Compatibility Report is included with the Kepler program.

PSYCHE & EROS Relationship Analysis: What is it you want to know when you are checking out a romantic relationship? Basically two things. First, you want to understand the emotional needs, temperament, hang-ups and issues each person brings to the relationship - in other words, the relationship potential of each person. And then, of course, you want to understand how the emotional needs, temperament, hang-ups and issues of one person relate to those of another person in order to see how they would get along - in other words, the compatibility analysis.

The Psyche and Eros Relationship Analysis consists of 4 sections: the first two sections describe the relationship potential of each person, and sections 3 and 4 are the compatibility analysis, describing how the two people experience each other and the relationship from the perspective of each person. About 17 pages in length. *Currently Available in English only*

COMPATIBILITY & CONFLICT: Rather than interpret every interaction between two charts, this report by well-known astrologer Dorothy Oja interprets only particularly important aspects between the two charts and relationships between zodiac sign placements. Aspects to the ruler of the 7th house cusp, aspects to angles, aspects to inner planets, and important zodiac sign placements are interpreted. In this way, the major themes and issues of the relationship are revealed. About 10-12 pages in length. *Currently Available in English only*

THE COMPOSITE REPORT: This report by Art Poppe analyzes romantic relationships by analyzing the composite chart in detail. Composite charts are very popular among professional astrologers for a very simple reason: they work! In this report Art Poppe interprets the composite chart in detail: the rising sign and decanate, as well as signs on other cusps, house and sign placements, aspects, and midpoint structures are interpreted. About 10-12 pages in length. *Currently Available in English only*

HEAVEN SENT: This report by Maxine Taylor is divided into two sections. The first deals with planets in houses, that is, which of your natal houses are triggered by his/her planets and vice versa. The second section deals with planets in aspect, or how your planets relate to each other. This report is about 5-10, pages in length. *Currently Available in English only*

Forecast Reports:

A Forecast Report predicts future trends - what is likely to occur over the coming months, days, or even years.

The Kepler and Pegasus program includes the "Cosmo Forecast Report". There are also many optional reports; these optional reports require Kepler to run. Each of the Forecast Reports is described below.

ADVANCED FORECAST: This report is an expanded version of the Basic Forecast Report by Gina Ronco. Interpretations of the 4 major asteroids and Chiron (written by Maureen Hajjar) and midpoints (written by Jeff Jawer) can also be included. For example, if transiting Chiron is conjunct natal Sun, or transiting Uranus is trine natal Vesta, transiting Pluto is conjunct the Sun/Moon midpoint, or the transiting Uranus/Pluto midpoint is opposition natal Mars, it will be interpreted. (Interpretations of asteroids in midpoint structures are not available). When running a forecast based on progressed-to-natal aspects, these influences can also be added. The Advanced Forecast also has one other advantage over the Basic Forecast Report by Gina Ronco: interpretations of quincunxes are included. The Advanced Forecast Report does not remove any capabilities of the Basic Forecast Report; it simply gives the additional capabilities of midpoint and asteroid interpretations. One other feature that is in the Advanced Forecast Report, but not the Basic Forecast Report, is the ability to produce a forecast report in Daily Format; in this format one interpretation is given per day based on the strongest aspects in effect on that day. The approximate length for one month is about 25-30 pages. *Currently available in English only*

BASIC FORECAST: You can run either a transit-to-natal or progressed-to-natal report; you cannot combine transits and progressions in one report but you can run them as separate reports. Major aspects (conjunctions, oppositions, squares, trines, and sextiles) formed between the transiting and natal planets are interpreted, and also planets through the houses. Outer planet transits are treated in detail and inner planet transit interpretations are short and succinct. The approximate length for one month is about 13-20 pages. *Languages available: English, Spanish, French, Portuguese, Norwegian, Russian*

POPPE FORECAST: This report by Art Poppe is well-written, specific and detailed, with suggestions on how to best deal with the astrological influences. This report allows you to select which aspects, transiting planets, and natal planets are desired so that you can produce reports with a varying degrees of detail. There are interpretations of the traditional aspects (conjunction, opposition, square, trine, and sextile). Art's report includes semisquare, sesquiquadrate, and quincunx aspects. Another unique feature of this report is that you can interpret transiting midpoint structures, either transiting planet to natal midpoint and/or transiting midpoint to natal planet. The approximate length for 15 days is about 15-20 pages. *Currently available in English only.*

ASTROJOURNEY Forecast for Teens and Young Adults: This AstroJourney Forecast for Teens and Young Adults is written by Kathie Garcia. This forecast report is unique! It is written specifically for people in the 14 to 24 year age range, and focuses on issues that are important to this age group. Teens and young adults too often are the neglected age group! This time period in any person's life is critically important, a time when a person struggles to establish his/her own identity and values, and moves forwards to adult responsibilities, decisions, and commitments. This report was written by an experienced and well-known

astrologer with the help of her own children who are in their teens and twenties and some of their friends. The result is a report written in modern language for modern times for today's young people crossing the bridge from childhood to adulthood, young people in today's fast-paced and quickly changing times. The approximate length for one month is about 10 pages. *Currently available in English only.*

DESTINY & DECISIONS: Riley Goodwin's Destiny and Decisions Forecast is down-to-earth and practical. He gives suggestions on how to best handle the astrological influences as well. Riley worked on this project for many years, and the care and attention that he put into this project is evident in the high quality of the final product. The approximate length for one month is about 10 pages. *Currently available in English only*

MINI-MINDER: Art Poppe has written a very nifty new Forecast Report. This report sells for \$75 and provides very brief interpretations of transits, including the option to include midpoint interpretations. Each interpretation is clear, concise, and focuses on tangible, concrete issues, avoiding detailed psychological analysis. Even though interpretations are very short, the length of a report is not short if you include midpoint interpretations because midpoint interpretations lengthen a forecast report significantly. The approximate length for one month is about 10-12 pages. *Currently available in English only.*

PORTUGUESE FORECAST: This report is similar to the Basic Forecast Report. It interprets transiting planets forming major aspects to natal planets. Planets through the houses are also interpreted. Outer planet transits are treated in detail and inner planet transit interpretations are short and succinct. The approximate length for one month is about 10 pages.

LOVE & ROMANCE FORECAST: For people very concerned about love and romance, this report focuses just on these issues. This report outlines the aspects between the transiting planets and the following three natal planets: Moon, Venus, and Pluto. The approximate length for three months is about 12 pages. *Languages available: English, Spanish, Portuguese*

KARMIC FORECAST: This report by Rosa Maria Viniestra is available at the current time in Spanish and Portuguese only. This forecast report focuses only on issues of a karmic and more inner nature. The approximate length for three months is about 15 pages. *Languages available: Spanish, Portuguese*

BUSINESS FORECAST: This report gives future trends for people engaged in running a business or making business decisions. This report interprets transiting-to-natal aspects that strongly affect one's business pursuits. The approximate page length for three months is about 6 pages. *Languages available: English, Spanish, Portuguese*

COSMO FORECAST: The Cosmo Forecast provides interpretations of transiting Sun, Mercury, Venus, and Mars to the natal planets. Note that because the outer planets (Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto) are not interpreted, this report is not complete and does not include the influences of the very important and powerful effects of outer planet transits. The interpretations are the same text that is contained in the most comprehensive Basic Forecast.

Progressions Report:

Transits, progressions, and solar returns are three of the most common astrological forecasting methods. A progression is a kind of unfolding of the birth chart over time based on a cosmic ratio like a day to a year. Don't worry, you don't need to understand the theory of progressions to read this interpretation of your progressed chart!

SECONDARY PROGRESSED REPORT: This report interprets the signs, the aspects, and the house positions in the progressed chart. The zodiac sign placements in the progressed chart and natal chart are also compared to each other. This report takes a rigorous approach to interpreting the secondary progressed chart, and the high quality of the final product reflects the care and attention that went into creating it. Like Riley Goodwin's natal report analysis, this report is well-written and based on Riley's many years of astrological consulting with clients and his years of study and research in astrology. It is about 15 pages in length. *Currently available in English only*

Horary Report:

Horary astrology analyzes the chart for the moment that a question is asked rather than analyzing a person's birth chart. Horary astrology was widely used throughout the Middle Ages and the rules used in horary astrology are rather complex and sophisticated. Some modern day astrologers also practice horary astrology as well.

ASTROQUEST HORARY: Randall Roffe, DC has designed a Horary Report to answer questions of any nature. Randall provides likely outcomes based on the planetary positions of the time and place of the question and combines this with natal chart aspects of the individual. Descriptions are given of the general situation, the questioner, the quesited object or person and much more. The horary program is a very helpful tool for the student of astrology and also a beneficial guide for anyone who wishes to be aided in their inquiries. Astroquest Horary Program is written in a very detailed but comprehensive language and would benefit a wide range of readers. It is about 10-12 pages in length. New! Astro LoveQuest Report now included!

With the release of Kepler 5.0 in November, 2001 the AstroQuest Report now includes the ability to produce a shorter report geared specifically towards questions regarding issues of love and romance. *Currently available in English only*

Solar & Lunar Return Reports:

A return is the moment that a transiting planet returns to the position it occupied at birth. For example, suppose that a person's Sun position is 14 degrees 20 minutes of Cancer. At about the time of the person's birth day each year the Sun will return to precisely this position of 14 degrees 20 minutes of Cancer. A chart constructed for this exact moment when the Sun returns to 14 degrees 20 minutes of Cancer is the solar return chart. Similarly, the Moon will return to the position it had at birth approximately once a month. A chart constructed for this time is the lunar return chart.

SOLAR RETURN REPORT: Horacio Valsecia's analysis of the solar return chart is very thorough, analyzing both the solar return chart and its relationship to the natal chart to determine trends for the coming year. This report is essentially divided into two parts. The first part analyzes the general external conditions of the year and the opportunities or problems that could occur in different areas.

The second part analyzes the twelve astrological houses, marking specially in what area of your life the various astral influences will be manifested, emphasizing your probably responses and inner changes. It is about 15 pages in length.

PLANETS IN SOLAR RETURN: This report is written by Mary Fortier Shea. The information in this report is based on the author's experience interpreting hundreds of Solar Return charts for clients over a 20 year period. Included in your report is an interpretation of retrograde Mercury, Venus and Mars, hemispheric and quadrant emphasis, preponderances and lacks, and each planet in every Solar Return house. Through the report, Mary Fortier Shea concentrates on a complete description of possibilities. Her examples range from spiritual transitions, starting a new business, love affairs, marriage, issues involving children and parents, health, education, writing and publishing books, relocation, income changes, career transitions, and much more. She covers both positive and negative possibilities for the different Solar Return placements and configurations she discusses. About 10-15 pages in length.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS: This report is a very comprehensive analysis of the solar return chart. Interpretations are lengthy and detailed. About 17-19 pages in length.

LUNAR RETURN REPORT: Horacio Valsecia has developed a helpful guide that is based on a monthly chart calculated for the time when the moon returns to the exact position it was at the time of birth. The Lunar Return happens every 28 days, or about 3 times a year. These interpretations provide insights into possible events in a descriptive and comprehensive way while giving suggestions on how to deal with the positive as well as negative planetary aspects. The objective of this report is to offer a practical guide to the situations that will arise in the coming months. One month is about 3 pages in length. *Languages available: English, Spanish*

THIRTEEN MOONS LUNAR RETURN: This astrological analysis of the lunar return chart is very detailed and thorough, being about a dozen pages for each lunar return.

Cities & Towns Reports:

Cities and Towns reports describe astrological influences of any locality. These reports can be referred to when planning vacations, visits, business traveling, or relocating. Both reports use aspects and 13 midpoint structures to the relocated Ascendant and Midheaven to derive the astrological interpretations.

CITIES & TOWNS: Are you thinking about moving, and wondering how you will like the new location? Or perhaps you are deciding on a place to vacation. Select up to 20 cities or towns, and the Cities and Towns Report will provide a brief description (about 1/3 to 1/2 page per location) of what you can expect in this location. *Languages available: English, Spanish, German, French*

RELOCATION INFORMATION: The Relocation Information Report provides an analysis of each town that is a little more detailed (about 1/2 page to 1 page per location) than the Cities and Towns Report. Astrologer Art Poppe, who wrote this report, uses similar techniques as those used by Gina Ronco in the Cities and Towns Report.

ASTROMED: This report by Dr. Randall Roffe, D.C. provides an astrological analysis of the natal chart with therapeutic indications based on Chinese and Ayurvedic healing, traditional medicine, western herbalism, yoga therapy, applied kinesiology and meric chiropractic, nutritional medicine, and homeopathy. About 10 pages in length. Currently available in English only.

COSMOBIOLOGY HEALTH REPORT: This report by Agnes Nightingale is designed to serve as a guide for those interested in researching the predisposition to disease in an astrological chart. Meant to gain a fairly quick general overview, it gives only short descriptions of the predominant influences. About 9-11 pages in length. Currently available in English only.

MEDSCAN: MedScan interprets element balances, heavily aspected planets, and other astrological factors, and provides details about your health, including what vitamin and other deficiencies are likely. Homeopathic and nutritional recommendations are provided. This report is written by well-known medical astrologer Eileen Nauman. About 10 pages in length. Languages available: English, Spanish, Portuguese, & Russian.

MEDICAL FORECAST: Eileen Nauman, author of our Medscan Report, has developed a transit forecast report that describes the influence of transiting planets on human health and well-being, thus providing indications of tendencies for changes in health. Homeopathic and nutritional recommendations are provided. Currently available in English only.

SCREENS & CHARTS

Kepler's Main Menu



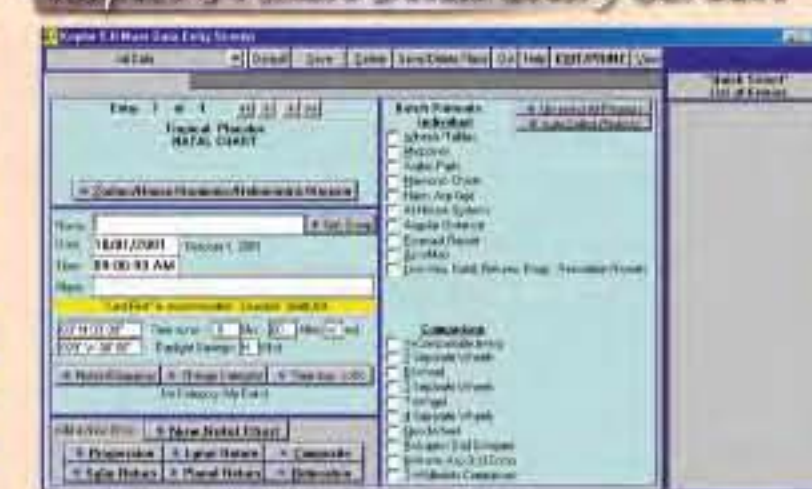
Kepler's Main Menu:

On this screen you can select "Encyclopedia" to look up an astrological topic or term, or select "Avalon College" for a self-guided astrology course. "AstroSearch" brings you to the research part of Kepler, and "ArtGallery" is a fun place to browse through graphics and optionally print them. Select "Help" for the on-line manual. "Customize" and "Edit" are used to set default values and make other custom changes. The heart of the Kepler program for many people is calculating charts and producing interpretations; click on the Main Data Entry Screen image to do this.

Main Data Entry Screen:

On this screen you enter the person's name, date, time, and place of birth. After entering the birth data, or reading it from disk, you can select one of the buttons in the lower left corner to get a progressed chart, solar return, composite, etc. To enter a second person's birth data, select the New Natal Chart button. You can have as many chart entries as desired. A progressed chart, return chart, etc. is an entry just like a natal chart, so you can select these charts just as easily as natal charts. You can also select the printout check boxes on the right side.

Selecting Chart Wheel



After selecting "Wheels/Tables" on Kepler's Main Data Entry Screen, Kepler allows you to select a wheel style, as shown on the left. Different astrologers have different preferences in a chart wheel. As you select the basic wheel style that you want (for example, "Small Wheel, Big aspect grid", Kepler shows a preview of the wheel in reduced size so you know exactly what it looks like. There are many other details of the chart wheel that you can control which are not shown on this screen display. You can also select BiWheels and TriWheels (if you are new to astrology you may not know what these are, but they are useful to astrologers) from Kepler's Main Data Entry Screen, and make similar selections.

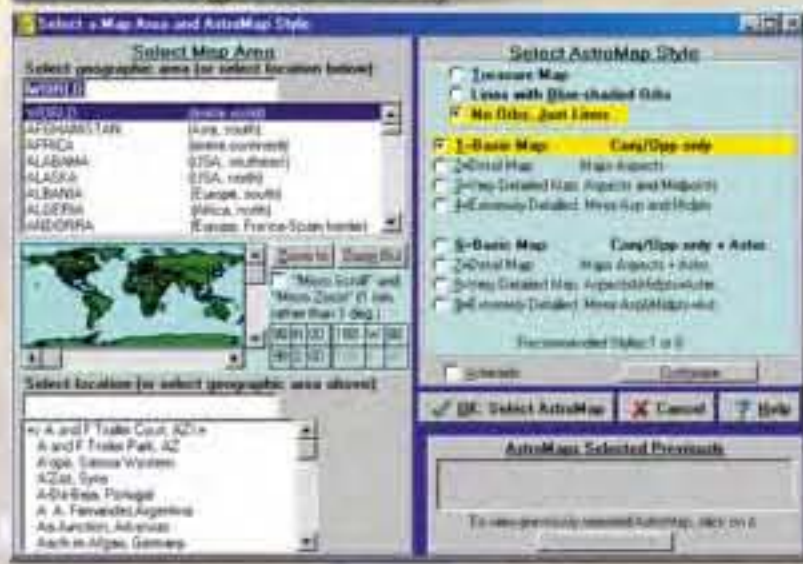
Viewing Chart Wheels on the Screen:

The sample chart wheels shown below are difficult to read because, like the sample screens shown above, they have been reduced; in actual size they are more readable. While viewing the wheel, you can easily select a different printout to view by selecting from the list of printouts on the right side of the screen. For example, suppose you would like to see the midpoints, or the Cosmo Natal interpretation, or Major Life Themes interpretation: you can click on these selections in the list of printouts on the right side of the screen. If you want to select a different chart wheel style, simply right click anywhere on the screen, the Select Chart Wheel Style box will then be displayed. Many users enjoy this "interactive" way of making selections, while others prefer "batch" selection during entry of the birth data. If you want a printed copy of a printout, click on the "Print This Screen". To e-mail the chart wheel, click on E-mail This Screen.

Selecting AstroMap



After selecting AstroMap in the Data Entry Screen, the screen shown on the left is displayed.

The geographic region selected is seen in a preview on the left side of the screen. In the upper-right corner you select the kind of map desired: Just Lines, Map with Blue-Shaded Orbs or Treasure Map. Which aspects and planets are selected just below this.

From Kepler's Main Data Entry Screen, you can select as many printouts as desired for as many people as desired (on the Main Data Entry Screen select the "New Natal Chart" button to start entering data for a new person). Some users, however, prefer to enter only birth data in the Main Data Entry Screen, and select printouts interactively while viewing the information on the screen. Displayed on the right is an AstroMap of the world. This is a traditional AstroMap; many users find that the innovative Treasure Maps are even more informative and useful than traditional AstroMaps.

Kepler Sample Chart Wheels

Kepler can produce many different kinds of chart wheels. The samples shown here are just a few of the many possibilities, and you can also customize chart wheels as well. Chart wheels are available in Portrait and Landscape format.

Kepler allows you to change the size of the chart wheel, the way in which cusps are drawn and planets are placed in the wheel, colors, and what tables appear, which planets and tables appear in the wheel, and how much information to put in the aspect grid, etc. Graphic pictures can also be placed in the background. If you are a beginner in astrology, then these options may

not interest you at this time, but if you are a professional astrologer, this flexibility and customizability will be important to you.

Every astrologer has his/her own unique way of doing things. Some astrologers want a chart wheel with the planets on the outside of the ring, or midpoint trees with 16th harmonic aspects, and some just want plain and simple information. Kepler is flexible and versatile enough for the technical astrologer who is fussy about how information is presented and simple enough for the novice, and also filled with instructional information to help you.

Wheel Style AAA

This small wheel size has room for a large aspect grid that gives detailed information: angular distance, aspects, orb and whether the aspect is applying or separating. You can customize many features of any chart wheel style. Many users select the wheel style that is closest to their favorite wheel style and then customize the wheel to their liking.

This wheel style is a bit larger than wheel style AAA and also uses the True Node instead of the Mean Node. You have the option of selecting equal or unequally spaced houses. In this case we have chosen unequally spaced houses. Small medium and large grids can be selected. This particular style uses the medium size grid.

This small wheel and small grid allows more details to fill in this page. You have the option to include explanation tables which is a helpful tool for beginning students, and your clients an customers. In the explanation tables you will find zodiac signs and planets symbols, etc. The color scheme shown here is Rainbow Bright.

4 Separate Wheels

4 Separate Wheels

You can place 2 wheels, 3 wheels, or 4 wheels on the screen display or printed page. Shown here is a sample of 4 wheels. You can easily select wheels for different people, or for the same person, and you can just as easily select progressed, returns, composite, or relocated charts just as easily as natal charts. You could also select some, or all, of the wheels to be heliocentric, harmonic charts, etc.

A QuadWheel is similar to a TriWheel, but has 4 rings instead of 3. On all of the chart wheels there is a place for your company name. Note that we do not put our company name Cosmic Patterns on any of your printouts, so the printouts can look exactly the way you want them to. The color scheme shown here is Stunning Green.

A big wheel is shown here. A small aspect grid fits in the lower left corner. We selected the Mean Node and equally spaced houses. Notice that the planets are drawn from the outside of the circle towards the inner circle. The Color Scheme is Turquoise Blue. Kepler comes with many wheel variations so it is unlikely that you will need to customize your own.

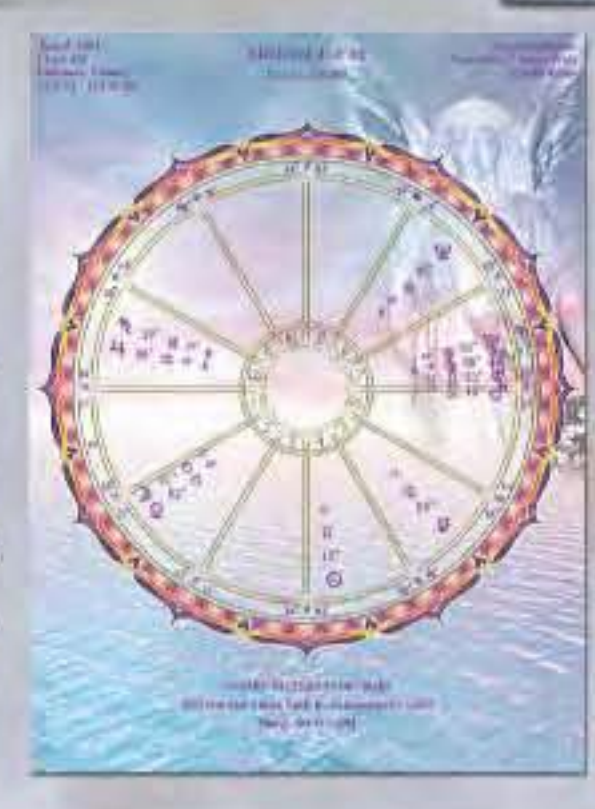
TriWheel Style AGE

A TriWheel has 3 rings, and each ring is a different chart. Just as with separate wheels, you can easily select any kind of chart for any person desired. The color scheme shown here is Blueberry Plus. This color scheme, like Rainbow Bright has a background color, but it is more subtle than the rainbow effect in the Rainbow Bright color scheme. The aspect lines in the center are optional.

The art wheel shown here is one of the 30 art wheels that come with the Kepler program. The background sky, water, and angel in pastel blues and pinks makes a beautiful background for this intricately patterned chart wheel.
